OUR CONVICTION



- Adaptation to climate change is **essential but often a neglected issue** : an international online event can help **regional inter-collaboration and raise awareness**
- Although climate change is global and linked to systemic actions, the **adaptation topic can be addressed locally** and students can lead **significant initiatives at their level**
- Vulnerability to climate risks is **unequal** and we must not leave anyone behind in the adaptation process: multi-disciplinary teams will help to address the **challenge of inclusion.**

The **Egis Foundation** is launching in early 2022 an **International Student Challenge** to address Adaptation to climate change aspects :



WHY ?

- Foster and reward the **creativity and empowerment of students** in the field of climate change
- **Create bounds** between our employees and students in all our geographies
- Get students & universities know better **Egis comitment** in these topics
- Attract talents to **increase Egis leverage** on climate change



WHO ?

- Students in engineering and social sciences
- Students from our partner universities
- All interested students and former students (up to 2 years after diploma)

HOW ?

- An online platform **agorize** will host the challenge during **12 weeks**
- Challenge to be performed **by teams** (2 – 5 people)
- Students will propose their **ideas**, look up for **team mates** and **develop** their projects on the platform
- We will provide **inspiring content** and **mentoring** from Egis employees



THE AWARD CEREMONY



The 3 laureates will be given the opportunity to present their project at the **UNESCO** event : the **Earth University** in Paris in November 2022

MAKE IT YOUR LOCAL CHALLENGE AS PART OF YOUR EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM

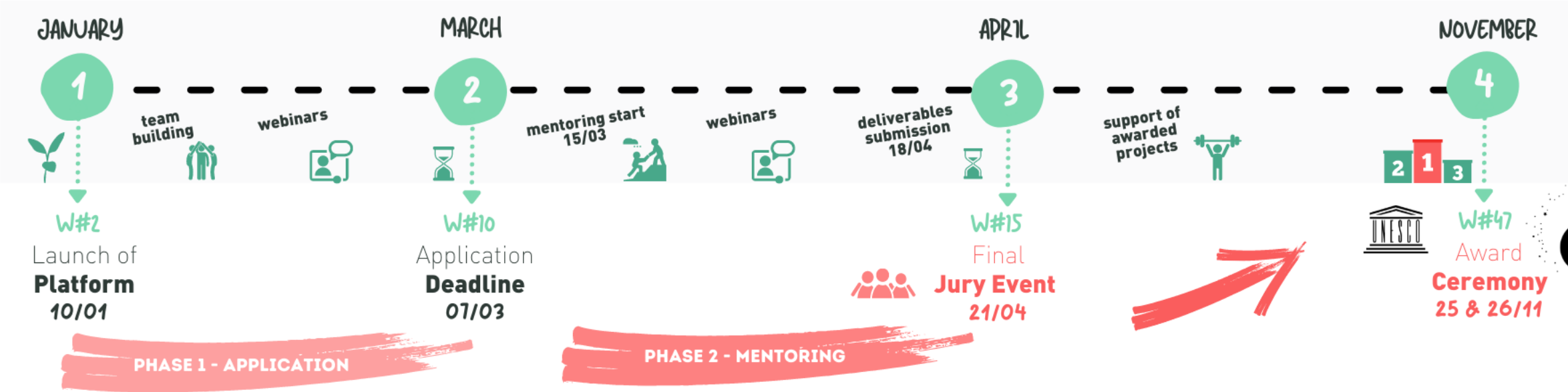
The framework opens to local climate change problematics and vulnerabilities. **Foster the creativity in your Campus** and make your students carry out their projects as part of your curriculum!

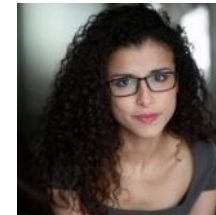

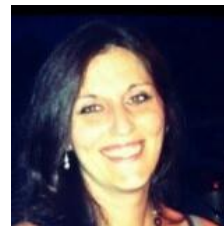
